### Reference Library Access and Research

The Koorie Heritage Trust reference library holds around 4,000 items, relating to the history and culture of the Aboriginal people of South Eastern Australia. The collection includes publications by the Koorie Heritage Trust, historic books, contemporary published works, unpublished documents, theses, serials, posters, maps and some published audio-visual items.
