The Koorie Heritage Trust is calling for Entries to the Koorie Art Show 2018

The Koorie Art Show is our annual award exhibition showcasing the diverse talent of Victoria's Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander artists in one inclusive space. The awards will be announced at the exhibition launch on *Saturday December 8, 2018*. The exhibition will be on display in our galleries until Sunday February 24, 2019.

Deadline for entries is Monday October 8, 2018

We encourage all Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander artists living in Victoria to participate. All submitted entries will be included in the exhibition and eligible for awards.

Competition Details

Entry forms must be returned to the Koorie Heritage Trust by **5pm Monday October 8, 2018**;

All artwork must be delivered between **9am - 4pm Monday November 19 – Friday November 30, 2018**;

Each artist may submit up to 2 works;

Works must have a hanging system or have a stand and must be ready to be installed;

Each artwork must have artist name, contact details, title of artwork and correct orientation noted either on the back of the artwork (2D) or on a tag attached to the work (3D);

Exhibition runs from Saturday December 8, 2018 – Sunday February 24, 2019.

Metro Tunnel Creative Program Award \$5,000

Koorie Heritage Trust People's Choice Award \$500

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- Deadline for return of Entry Forms is 5pm Monday October 8, 2018;
- Entry into the Koorie Art Show is open to Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander artists who reside in Victoria and are 17 years of age and over;
- There is no fee associated with entering the Show;
- All artworks must be for sale and eligible to win prizes;
- You can enter up to two artworks;
- Artworks must be original and produced in the 18 months prior to the Friday November 30 delivery;
- Entries after this date will not be accepted;
- The KHT reserves the right at any time to refuse an entry should it be considered inappropriate in standard and content, unsafe, poorly constructed or not meet these terms and conditions. In this instance, you will be notified by KHT staff;
- The KHT reserves the right to install and display the artwork as it sees fit;
- The judge's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into;

DELIVERY OF ARTWORKS

- Artworks must be delivered to the Koorie Heritage Trust between:
9am - 4pm Monday November 19 - Friday November 30;
- Artworks must be delivered ready to display;
- Artworks can be framed, stretched, mounted or pinned but must be delivered ready to hang;
- Artworks must be submitted with a label on the back listing the following: title of work, name of artist, contact details and correct orientation of work.
- All posted artworks must be posted via registered post and have a tracking number which you share with Koorie Heritage Trust staff.

FREIGHT AND INSURANCE

- Freight and insurance is the responsibility of the artist. The KHT accepts no responsibility for damage to artwork while in transit to and from the gallery.

USE OF IMAGES

- By entering, you consent to the KHT and/or sponsors using images of your artwork to promote the show and the Koorie Heritage Trust & its activities.

ARTWORK SALES

- KHT will conduct the sale of all artworks;
- The prices on artworks must be the price you want from the sale of the work and must only include GST if you are registered.
- KHT will add a 30% commission to the sale price of each work;
- For example if the price you want for your work is \$500 (inc GST) the retail price will be \$665. The original \$500 will go to the artist the \$165 commission (including GST) will go to KHT;
- Artworks will not be released to buyers until the exhibition is finished and full payment for the artwork is made;
- You will be notified of sales on conclusion of the Show. You will be paid money owing to you from the sale of your artwork no longer than four weeks after the conclusion of the show.

COLLECTION OF UNSOLD WORKS

- Unsold artwork must be collected by appointment between Monday February 25 - Monday March 4, 2019; Please call us if you are unable to collect work on these days;
- Unless prior arrangements have been made all uncollected work will be destroyed 8 weeks after the closing of the exhibition.

ENTRANT DECLARATION

By signing this document, I warrant that I have read, agree to and abide by, the conditions of entry as set out in the Terms and Conditions of entry and I declare that I fit the eligibility criteria through my own self-assessment including being recognized as a member of the Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander community in Victoria. I declare that the work submitted is my original authentic work and does not infringe the copyright or moral rights of another person or group. I also declare that the work is subject to Indigenous laws in regard to the use of traditional designs and I warrant that where my artwork displays cultural heritage specific to a group within the Indigenous community, that I have followed cultural protocols and obtained the relevant permission. I acknowledge that I retain full copyright of the work and I give permission for the work to be reproduced by media and to be photographed prior to and during the exhibition for promotional and exhibition documentation purposes. This application is a contract between the entrant/artist and the Koorie Heritage Trust, the terms of which are in this document.
