## **Reference Library Access**

The reference library is primarily held by the Koorie Heritage Trust for our Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander community members and researchers, to assist with research requests relating to local history and culture. If you are a community member wanting to access the library, please complete the access request form to make an appointment with one of our collection staff who will be happy to assist you.

As a not-for-profit community organisation, the Koorie Heritage Trust charges service fees for non-community members to access the reference library. These fees apply to non-Indigenous researchers, who are not working on a project in partnership with the Koorie Heritage Trust. Please see the reference library fee structure below.

Due to limited staff resources, the reference library is accessible by appointment only. The Koorie Heritage Trust does not have a paid researcher on staff, and therefore cannot assist the development of research topics, or general research enquiries not related to our Collections.
