The 2nd Kids and Youth Awards will showcase the diverse talents of Victoria's Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander young people in one inclusive space

The Show will be launched, and awards announced on Saturday 7 December 2019 and entries will be on display in our Level 2 Project Space until Sunday 23 February 2020

This entry form must be submitted with the artwork between Monday 18 November and Sunday 24 November 2019

We encourage all Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander budding artists living in Victoria to participate



Competition Details

Who are you and what is your story?

The theme for the 2nd **Koorie Art Show: Kids and Youth Awards 2019** is **'Connection to Country'**

All artworks must reflect on the theme, however, you can utilise whatever medium you would prefer to work in. This entry form is for artists aged between 5 & 16 years old. If you are 17 years or older, please fill out the form for adult applicants. This entry form must be returned to the Koorie Heritage Trust between **Monday 18 November and Sunday 24 November 2019** at the same time as when you drop your works off for installation

Each artist may submit 1 artwork only (either 2D, 3D or digital)

Two-dimensional works must not exceed 45 x 45cm – this includes frame

Three-dimensional works must not exceed 45 x 45 x 45cm – this includes stand

Your artwork must be delivered between **9am – 4pm Monday 18 November and Sunday 24 November 2019**

The artworks will be installed on Monday 25th November so late applications will not be accepted as there will not be time to install them. The Show will run from Saturday 7 December 2019 until Sunday 23 February 2020, and will be shown in our Level 2 Project Gallery. All submitted works will be shown

Prizes

Prizes will be awarded to artists that show exceptional creativity in their response to the theme; 'Connection to Country'. Prizes will be split into age groups; 5-10 years, and 11-16 years as follows:

5 – 10 years Award (2 x Gift Cards to the value of \$100 each)

5 – 10 years Encouragement Award (2 x Gift Cards to the value of \$250 each)

11 – 16 years Award (2 x Gift Cards to the value of \$100 each)

11 – 16 years Encouragement Award (2 x Gift Cards to the value of \$250 each)

I acknowledge that I retain full copyright of the work and I give permission for the work to be reproduced by media and to be photographed prior to and during the exhibition for promotional and exhibition documentation purposes.

LEVEL 2 ACCESS NOTE

There is no public lift access to the Level 2 Project Space. Access is via 1 set of escalators (going up) and 23 stairs with 1.3 metre landing and hand rails on both sides of stairs (going down). If you are unable to walk down 23 stairs, you can continue up another set of escalators to Level 3 to take our public lift down to the ground entrance. On Saturday 7 December lift access to Level 2 will be made available

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- This entry form must be submitted with the artwork between Monday 18 November and Sunday 24 November 2019. Entries after this date will not be accepted except in exceptional circumstances or where the closing date is extended
- Entry into the Show is only open to Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander kids and youth who reside in Victoria and are between 5-16 years of age
- There is no fee associated with entering the Show
- You can enter one artwork only
- 2D works must not exceed 45 x 45cm; 3D works/digital art must not exceed 45 x 45 x 45cm
- Artworks must be original and produced in the 18 months prior to 24 November 2019
- The KHT reserves the right at any time to refuse an entry should it be considered inappropriate in standard and content, unsafe, poorly constructed or not meet these terms and conditions. In this instance, you will be notified by the Exhibition Curator
- The KHT reserves the right to display the artwork as it sees fit
- Children of KHT staff are permitted to enter artwork in the Show and will be eligible to win prizes
- The judge's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into
- Artworks entered into the Show will not be available for sale

CRITERIA FOR JUDGING

- To avoid any conflict of interests claim, the KHT has a policy and procedures to provide guidance and transparency in the selection of judges for the Show as well as the judging process. The full policy and procedures can be found on our webpage at www.koorieheritagetrust.com or contact us for a copy of the policy and procedures
- In selecting a judge, the KHT will satisfy itself and be confident of the integrity of the judges to make an impartial judging decision free of bias. The KHT will brief all judges on perceived or actual conflict of interests and the judges themselves will be reminded that they have a responsibility to advise the KHT of any such conflict. In general, the children of participating judges will be able to enter an artwork into the Show but the artwork will not be eligible for any prizes
- Works will be judged for an award based on compliance with the award criteria and the quality of the work, acknowledging this is subjective according to the judging panel

DELIVERY OF ARTWORKS

- Artworks must be delivered with the entry form to the KHT between 9am – 4pm Monday 18 November and Sunday 24 November 2019
- Artworks must be delivered ready to display
- Artworks can be framed, stretched, mounted or pinned but must be delivered ready to hang
- Artworks must be submitted with a label on the back listing the following: title of work, date of production of work, name of artist, contact details and correct orientation of work
- All posted artworks must be posted via registered post and have a tracking number which you may share with our curatorial staff
- If possible, please do not roll paper-based artwork

FREIGHT AND INSURANCE

- Freight and insurance is the responsibility of the parent/guardian of the artist
- The KHT accepts no responsibility for damage to artwork while in transit to and from the KHT

PUBLICITY

- By entering, you consent to the KHT and/or sponsors using images of the artwork to promote the Show, and the KHT and its activities

COLLECTION OF WORKS

- Artwork must be collected at the end of the Show, between Monday 24 February and Monday 2 March 2020. Please call us if you are unable to collect work on these days. Unless prior arrangements have been made, all uncollected artwork will be disposed of 8 weeks after the closing of the exhibition
